



Construction

Olean traffic was switched to the temporary lanes to start work on the North side of the roadway. Due to the concern for the safety of motorists and workers Caring Way was closed at Olean Boulevard, Construction supplies are being staged and stored on the Pond A site

Construction has begun on Sewer & Water, Stormwater Drainage on Caring Way Alley and Brinson Avenue. Stormwater Structures and Pipes were

constructed for the Pond A site. Stormwater drainage pipes are going under Caring Way and Brinson Avenue, Utility work is ongoing on the Caring Way Alley and will be going under Aaron Street in January



Future Traffic Advisories

These road closures will occur after the Holidays

January 2 - Brinson Avenue Closed **Between Caring Way and Aaron** Street

Brinson Avenue will be closed from Thursday, Jan. 2 until Thursday, Jan. 9. This closure is required for the contractor to install the new stormwater system across the roadway.

January 9 - Aaron Street Closed Between Olean Boulevard and **Brinson Avenue**

Aaron Street, between Olean Boulevard and Brinson Avenue, will be closed from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 9 until Saturday, Jan. 11. This closure is required for the contractor to install a sanitary sewer manhole.

Budget \$10,647,000

Currently in programming and design.

Construction start anticipated Summer 2020.





North Charlotte Aquatics Center

25yd x 50m pool, dive well, facilities

Budget \$7,500,000

Construction in progress, April 2020 completion



Sailing Center at PC Beach Park

Budget \$918,000; includes covered storage, pavilion, and fencing Design complete; construction start March 2020, complete December 2020

Placida Boat Ramp Expansion

Budget \$7,000,000; new 2-lane boat ramp, parking, restrooms Design in progress; lengthy permitting; complete by late 2022



Justice Center Generator

Budget \$900,000; provides emergency power support

GMP approved November 12. Construction to begin in later phase of project



Unfunded Placeholders

- Charlotte Harbor Trails and Wayfinding unfunded: \$1,000,000; waiting and see ~ local development
- Toledo Blade Widening unfunded: \$2,700,000; wait and see ~ local development
