"Save Our Pets" Sticker

In the case of fire, a natural disaster, or when a pet owner is not home at the time of an emergency, pets cannot fend for themselves. Emergency responders face the challenge of knowing if and what type of pet is in the home. In some situations Fire & EMS emergency responders respond for a medical emergency which requires the only resident in the home to be transported to the hospital with the expectation of an extended stay at a medical facility. In this situation Fire & EMS personnel will notify Animal Control officers that a pet could be left alone without anyone to care for the animal. Animal Control personnel will provide the proper assistance to the pet's owner for the care of the animal. CC Sheriff's Office personnel will also utilize the information on the Save Our Pets Sticker in many situations.
