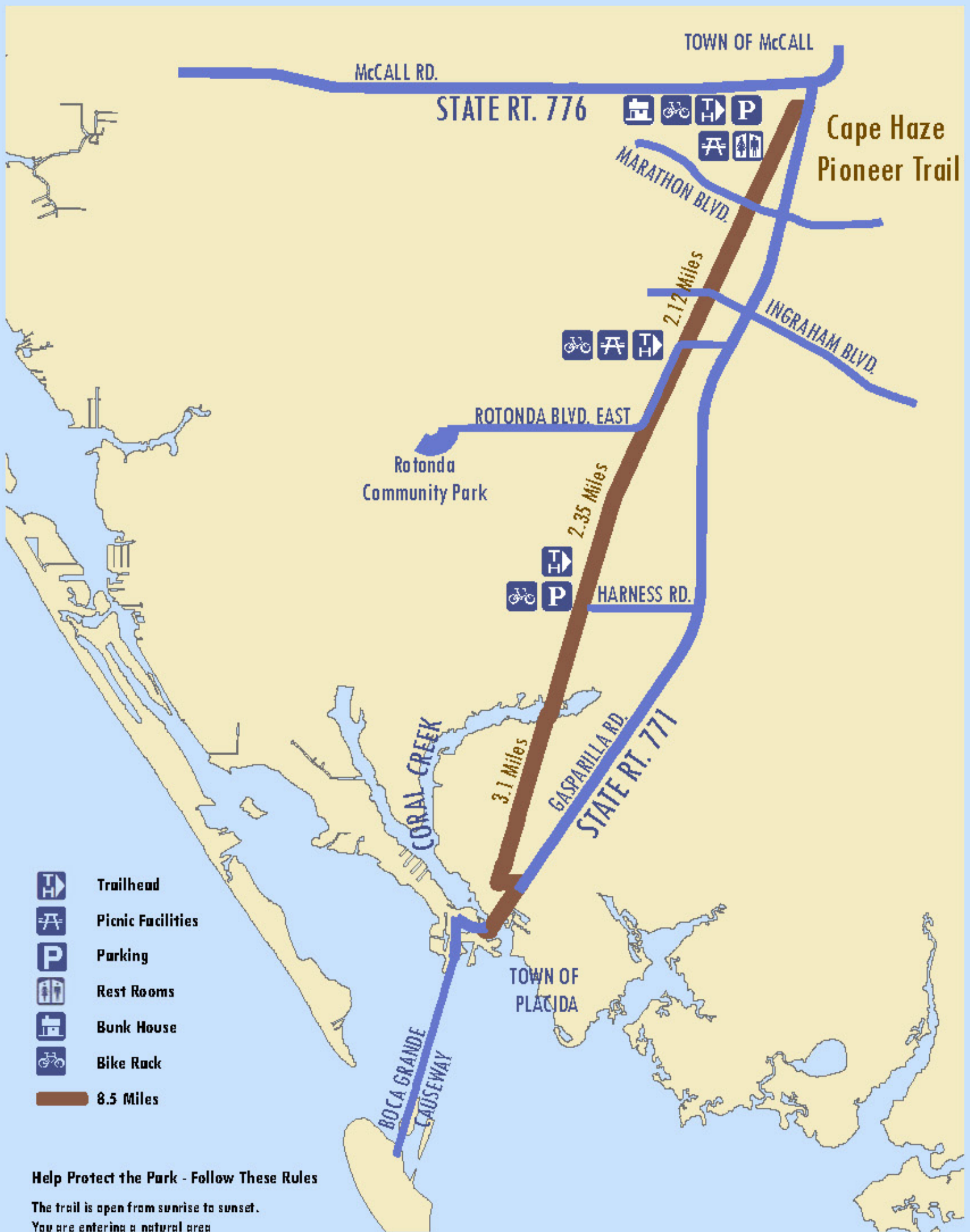


# CAPE HAZE PIONEER TRAIL



## Help Protect the Park - Follow These Rules

The trail is open from sunrise to sunset.

You are entering a natural area

- Respect and protect wildlife and all natural features
- Put litter in designated containers
- Glass containers prohibited
- Show courtesy and respect for all trail users

Safety is our highest priority

- Obey all traffic signs and signals
- Keep to the right, pass to the left
- Headphones are not permitted
- Stay on designated trails
- Leave valuables at home
- Lock your vehicle & take your keys with you
- For your safety, enjoy the greenway with a friend

Cyclists/skaters have special responsibilities

- Use helmets and other required protective gear
- Keep speed moderate and maintain control
- Give audible signal when passing
- Yield to pedestrians
- No racing

Motorized vehicles (except for the disabled, maintenance, law enforcement and emergency vehicles) are not allowed.

## A Dog Friendly Park

Cape Haze Pioneer Trail is one of Charlotte County's Dog Friendly Parks. Please keep it safe and follow these rules.

- Dog owners are responsible for the clean-up and removal of their dog's feces
- Dog owners are required to remain with their animals
- No more than two dogs per person on any one visit
- Dogs only
- No glass containers
- Dogs must wear a collar with a current license attached
- Dogs must be current on rabies vaccines
- Female dogs in heat are prohibited
- Dogs 4 months of age or under are prohibited
- No food allowed
- No smoking
- Owners must fill in any holes that their dog digs
- Dogs must be on a leash (voice command is not sufficient)
- Owners should be respectful of others
- Aggressive dogs are not permitted
- At the first sign of aggression the owner must remove their dog
