

Pool Rules

Charlotte County Community Services strives to provide an environment for the recreational enjoyment of all patrons. In an effort to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience,

the following general rules shall apply to all individuals.

Welcome to our facility!

- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the safety of their children.
- Lifeguards reserve the right to refuse admittance or eject from the pool premises unwilling to comply with lifeguard directions.
- Diving is permitted in designated diving area only.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a person 18 years or older.
- Children under the age of 6 and all non-swimmers must be accompanied by a person 18 years or older within arm's reach at all time.
- Only United States Coast Guard approved floatation devices are allowed.
- Swim diapers or rubber pants must be worn by all pool users not toilet trained.
- Proper swim attire must be worn in the pool, reference County ordinance #99-035.
- All patrons must pay admission fee when entering the facility.
- All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
- No food or beverages in pool or on wet deck.
- The following are prohibited for the safety of all users: diving, running, back flips, rafts, hanging on lines and ladders, glass containers, animals, swallowing pool water.
- The following are prohibited for the comfort of all users: horseplay, profanity, loud radios.

Dive Well Rules

- No horseplay.
- Only one bounce per dive.
- Only one person allowed on diving board at a time.
- Divers must wait with their feet on the pool deck until the diver ahead has reached the ladder.
- Once a diver enters the water, they must swim directly to the ladder.
- Forward entries only. No back dives, inward dives, or reversals are permitted except during supervised programs.
- Swimming in the dive well is prohibited while the diving board is in use.
- Swimmers wishing to use the diving boards may be asked to perform a swim test.
