#### Approval of Minutes:

- Updates included proposed revisions to the application timeline, buffer adjustments, potential school sites, and consideration of workforce housing.
- Committee members discussed unit counts, fencing, agricultural land concerns, flood planning, soil health, community longevity, agricultural easements, vegetation, longrange planning, and water quality management.

#### **New Business:**

#### **Discussion of ANRAC Functions:**

- Joe Lewis (Charlotte County resident) addressed concerns regarding COPART and the perception that the County is "rubber stamping" projects.
- Mr. Lewis requested that the COPART letter authored by Chairman Morris expressing ANRAC's concerns regarding the Pulte Homes project be read at the next Board of County Commissioners meeting.
- Chairman Morris made a motion to appoint two committee members to attend the
  October 28, 2025, BCC meeting, with one committee member to read the letter. It was
  seconded by Ms. Deuberry and passed unanimously.
- Volunteers to read letter at future BCC meeting: Scott Schroeder and James Ryals.
- Discussion ensued on improving public access to information about new projects. It was agreed that project PDFs should be sent to the committee liaison (Jennifer Williams) prior to each meeting for distribution to members.

#### Shaun Cullinan provided updates on the following:

- Water lines become County property once operational.
- Two proposed water mitigation banks: one in West County, one in East County (agricultural area).
- Development activity along U.S. 17 and Piper Road.
- Possible indoor storage project at Lakeside RV (commercial portion).
- Updates on COPART and Rural Settlement Area
- Potential new mine submittal near S.R. 31 and Washington Loop Road.
- Florida Power & Light solar field activity.
- Possible development south of the landfill near Burnt Store Road; LSI may sell agricultural land.
- Reservoir planned near railroad tracks on the east side of I-75.

#### **Member Comments:**

 Steve Kalaf raised a question regarding attendance by members of one committee at another committee's meeting. Kellie Stewart clarified under Sunshine Law, no more than two members of the same committee may attend without public notice, and only as members of the public. Mr. Cullinan advised he will consult with the County Attorney for confirmation.
