

Private Provider Registration Form

Charlotte County requires all private provider firms to complete a one-time registration. There is no fee associated with the registration. During this process, proper licensure and insurance are verified and documented. Private Providers are responsible for keeping registration records current.

Pursuant to Florida Statute 553.791, if Private Provider Plan Review is utilized, then Charlotte County requires that Private Provider Inspections also be utilized.
